LEED™ (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) is a globally recognized building certification system developed by the U.S. Green Building Council and is administrated by the Canada Green Building Council (CaGBC) in Canada. Its purpose is to provide independent verification of a real estate or building project's degree of resource efficiency. Areas covered include energy and water efficiency, indoor air quality, emissions, proximity to mass transit, use of recyclable materials, renewable energy, etc.

PURPOSE OF THE COURSE: This course is designed to help people to understand the LEED rating system in detail and take the necessary LEED exams if they like. Passing the LEED Exam allows professionals to have the required LEED AP designation to work in a team for certifying buildings.

COURSE DELIVERY MODE: In-class and at the same time in real-time online for remote attendees
Remote students will receive the course material prior to the class.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: Engineers, Architects, Building Owners and Managers, Developers, Energy Managers, Environmentalists, and individuals wishing to be educated about LEED and/or to write the exam to become either a Green Associate or a LEED accredited professional (AP).
